

GENERAL DELIVERY TERMS FOR READY-MIX CONCRETE

1 SCOPE

1.1

Ready-mix concrete deliveries shall comply with the General Procurement and Delivery Terms for Construction Products (RYHT 2000) and delivery terms for ready-mix concrete defined below, unless otherwise expressly agreed in writing.

2 ACCEPTANCE INSPECTION AND SUPERVISION OF DELIVERY

2.1

The Buyer or a person authorised by the Buyer shall check the delivery note to verify the compliance of the delivery with the order with respect to e.g. the strength class of the concrete, exposure class / planned service life, delivered amount, indicated admixtures, etc.

2.2

Any errors and shortcomings related to the delivery shall be immediately informed to the Seller.

2.3

The delivery shall be signed off as received by the Buyer or a person authorised by the Buyer. The Buyer shall provide to the Seller contact information for the person authorised by the Buyer prior to the start of the concrete delivery.

3 SERVICE AND WAITING TIME

3.1

The driver of the concrete truck shall record the service and the waiting time in the delivery note before the delivery is signed off as received.

4 DELIVERY TIME AND DELAYS

4.1

The General Procurement and Delivery Terms for Construction Products (RYHT 2000) shall be applied, unless otherwise agreed between the parties in the Procurement Contract or Supply Contract.

5 POSTPONEMENT OR CANCELLATION OF DELIVERY

5.1

The Buyer may postpone the delivery no later than six (6) hours before the agreed delivery time, with the Seller reserving the right of prior sale, or cancel the delivery by 14:00 o'clock on the previous working day. If the postponement or cancellation causes any extraordinary direct expenses to the Seller, the Seller shall have the right to recover them in full from the Buyer.

If a blanket delivery order¹⁾ is placed by the Buyer, the Seller shall have the right of prior sale.

6 TRANSPORTATION OF CONCRETE

6.1

The Buyer shall assume responsibility for acceptable driving conditions, sufficient load-bearing capacity and size of access roads and the discharge location to permit unimpeded access taking the properties of the concrete truck into account.

6.2

The Buyer or a person authorised by the Buyer shall indicate to the seller or to the driver of the concrete truck a location on the worksite for the disposal of residual concrete or cleaning residues.

¹⁾ A blanket delivery order is a preliminary order which becomes a delivery order when the Buyer confirms the delivery time to the Seller.
